

# PRELIMINARY AWARDS SCHEDULE



## TIMES FOR AWARDS CEREMONIES ARE TENTATIVE

Additional Ceremonies may be added or combined with an existing one

### DEFINITE TIMES FOR AWARDS CEREMONIES WILL BE POSTED BY NOON THE DAY PRIOR TO THE AWARDS CEREMONIES FOR THE FOLLOWING DAY

Championship classes will have awards in Ring 1 per the schedule below. A championship class will not be included in an awards ceremony unless the results for a class have been posted for at least fifteen minutes.

Riders should arrive and line up in the outdoor lunging arena **at their scheduled gather time listed on the definite time schedule**. If there are ride time conflicts or other concerns (e.g. fractious horse), please make a request for accommodations to Awards Coordinator at least **one hour prior** to start of ceremony. Except in the case of an emergency, requests to be excused from the awards ceremony must occur one hour prior to the scheduled ceremony gathering time. The requests must be made to the Awards Coordinator who must confer with the USDF Representative, the Competition Manager, and the Technical Delegate in the decision-making process. Riders should enter awards arena in reverse order (lowest to highest) at a walk past the photo op. Champion and reserve will stop in front of the photo op for recognition.

Following recognition and photographs, Champion will lead the lap of honor.

Great American/USDF Championships	Southwest Dressage Championships
Riders placing in Great American/USDF Regional Championship classes must be present, mounted and in full riding attire for awards ceremonies. Failure, without prior permission of the competition manager to be present and properly attired, will eliminate the official score and placing and the next highest score will move up in placing. For safety reasons competitors may decline to participate in the victory round. Unmounted awards ceremonies may be held if weather or other calamity prevents mounted awards ceremonies. Riders must be in full riding attire.	<b>The top three riders are required to return mounted for the awards ceremonies in order to receive their awards.</b> Riders should wear their Medals at all times during the show <b>EXCEPT</b> while riding.

## Photography/Videography

It is the Rider's responsibility to notify the Official Show Photographer and Videographer before your scheduled ride times. You may arrange for a posed photo in front of the decorated Sponsors' (Great American/USDF and SWDC) photo area **AFTER all the ride and ceremonies are completed.**

Riders are responsible for all fees.
